# Psalm 1

see Jeremiah 17:5-8

1 Blessed is the **man** that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

2 But his delight is in **the law** of the LORD; **and in his law doth he meditate day and night.**

### Joshua 1:8

This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; **but thou shalt meditate therein day and night**, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: **for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.**

3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

4 The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind driveth away.

5 Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

6 For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

# Psalm 2

1 Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing?

2 The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against **the LORD**, and against **his anointed**, saying,

3 Let us break their bands asunder, and cast away their cords from us.

4 He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh: the Lord shall have them in derision.

5 Then shall he speak unto them in his wrath, and vex them in his sore displeasure.

6 Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.

## Acts 4

### Peter & John

1 And as **they** spake unto the people, the priests, and the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees, came upon them, **2** Being grieved that they taught the people, and preached through Jesus the resurrection from the dead. **3** And they laid hands on them, and put them in hold unto the next day: for it was now eventide. **4** Howbeit many of them which heard the word believed; and the number of the men was about five thousand.

5 And it came to pass on the morrow, that their rulers, and elders, and scribes, **6** And Annas the high priest, and Caiaphas, and John, and Alexander, and as many as were of the kindred of the high priest, were gathered together at Jerusalem. **7** And when they had set them in the midst, they asked, **By what power, or by what name, have ye done this?**

**8** Then Peter, filled with the Holy Ghost, said unto them, **Ye rulers of the people, and elders of Israel, 9** If we this day be examined of the good deed done to the impotent man, by what means he is made whole; **10** Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

**11** This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. **12** Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

**13** Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus. **14** And beholding the man which was healed standing with them, they could say nothing against it.

**15** But when they had commanded them to go aside out of the council, **they conferred among themselves, 16** Saying, **What shall we do to these men? for that indeed a notable miracle hath been done by them is manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; and we cannot deny it. 17** But that it spread no further among the people, let us straitly threaten them, that they speak henceforth to no man in this name.

**18** And they called them, and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus.

**19** But Peter and John answered and said unto them, **Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God, judge ye. 20** For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.

**21** So when they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding nothing how they might punish them, because of the people: for all men glorified God for that which was done. **22** For the man was above forty years old, on whom this miracle of healing was shewed.

**23** And being let go, they went to their own company, and reported all that the chief priests and elders had said unto them. **24** And when they heard that, they lifted up their voice to God with one accord, and said, Lord, thou art God, which hast made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all that in them is:

**25** Who by the mouth of **thy servant David** hast said, **Why did the heathen rage, and the people imagine vain things?**

**26** The kings of the earth stood up, and the rulers were gathered together against the Lord, and against his Christ.

**27** For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together,

**28** For to do whatsoever thy hand and thy counsel determined before to be done. **29** And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word, **30** By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.

**31** And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

**Acts 13:29** And when they had fulfilled all that was written of him, they took him down from the tree, and laid him in a sepulchre. **30** But God raised him from the dead: **31** And he was seen many days of them which came up with him from Galilee to Jerusalem, who are his witnesses unto the people. **32** And we declare unto you glad tidings, how that the promise which was made unto the fathers, **33** God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again; **as it is also written in the second psalm, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee.**

**7** I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, **Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee.**

**8** Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.

**9** Thou shalt break them with **a rod of iron**; thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.

**Revelation 19:15** And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with **a rod of iron**: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and **wrath of Almighty God.**

**10** Be wise now therefore, O ye kings: be instructed, ye judges of the earth.

**11** Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling.

**12** Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when **his wrath** is kindled but a little.

**Revelation 6:14** And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places. **15** And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains; **16** And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from **the wrath of the Lamb**: **17** For the great day of his wrath is come; and **who shall be able to stand?**

Blessed are all they that put their trust in him.

**Revelation 2:26** And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations: **27** And he shall rule them with **a rod of iron**; **as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers**: even as I received of my Father.

# Psalm 3

A Psalm of David, when he fled from Absalom his son.

**1** LORD, how are they increased that trouble me! many are they that rise up against me.

**2** Many there be which say of my soul, There is no help for him in God.

**Selah.**

**3** But thou, O LORD, art a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.

**4** I cried unto the LORD with my voice, and he heard me out of his holy hill.

**Selah.**

**5** I laid me down and slept; I awaked; for the LORD sustained me.

**6** I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people, that have set themselves against me round about.

**7** Arise, O LORD; save me, O my God: for thou hast smitten all mine enemies upon the cheek bone; thou hast broken the teeth of the ungodly.

**8** Salvation belongeth unto the LORD: thy blessing is upon thy people.

## Deuteronomy 33

**8** And five of you shall chase an hundred, and an hundred of you shall put ten thousand to flight: and your enemies shall fall before you by the sword.
