Much Misinformation - who?
 & obvious Ishtar is from Satan - ^{1st Earth Age} false god
 Ishtar - The most documented - The first ^{to} be written about in Myths, Legends & Poems

She is depicted on Pottery dated To 2900 B.C.

Gen. 6: Noah's birth - 2948 B.C., Death - 1948 B.C.

Gen. 10:8-9 Nimrod - 2185 B.C.

Gen. 12: Abram called - 1921 B.C.

Easter was originally The celebration of Ishtar
 The Babylonian (Assyrian) goddess of
 Sex, Fertility & War (Hence the egg & bunny)

* NOT Necessarily Female *

She was associated with the planet Venus -
 (Known as The morning star) = Lucifer

star of Ishtar - 8 sided - still important today

she is Linked To ancient Sexual & Fertility Rituals

Her cult practised sacred prostitution

she is very ambitious and ^{one} of Ishtar's
 Titles is queen of Heaven

Ez. 8:16 She is considered the mother of Ba'al -
 The Babylonian god of the sun

she could give Life & Take it away

one story has her storming the
 Heavens - staging a divine coup

(Symbolic of Satan's Rebellion)

Now in The Pergamon Museum - Berlin

Ishtar gate of Babylon - a depiction

I Pet. 5:8 of a striding Lion (Satan)

also a Bull & the mythological Dragon

Ishtar - Easter

Ishtar + Ashteroth are the same goddess

- ① Ishtar - Babylonian
- ② AshtarTe - Phoenician
- ③ Ashteroth, Astaroth, Ashtoreth, Astarte
adopted by the Canaanites
from the Phoenicians
- ④ Asherah - The Greek Form
apparently adopted by the
Roman Church in Approx. 155 A.D.
(with its type of worship
and named it Easter)
* still have eggs + bunnies

In Greece she was associated with
Athena, Aphrodite + Venus - Throughout
Europe Temples To Athena have

Luke 11:27-28 become Temples To 'The Virgin Mary'

x verses 2nd half @ Ez. 8:14

Beginning In Both Sumerian and Greek/Roman
w/ Ez. 8:14 Legends she descends into the
underworld (marking the death of
the year 'winter') to rescue her
dead lover 'Tammuz', which is
reborn as 'spring' with her
Annual resurrection.

Ishtar is Mother (in some stories) and also
consort (lover) of Tammuz

Ez. 8:13-14 LENT = Tammuz was killed and Ishtar
instituted an annual ritual of
40 days of mourning for Ba'al
worshippers, when no meat
could be eaten.

Ash Wed. = First day - The ashes were said
to be the seed of the fire-god Agni
deemed to have the power to forgive sins.
